

## **CODE OF CONDUCT 2025-26**

## The following are basic rules of behaviour that apply to all students.

- 1. Students must arrive on time and remain present for the duration of the class session.
- 2. Do not use mobile phones during class or break time unless authorised to do so by the teacher for educational purposes. Mobile phones will be collected from students at the beginning of each class session and can be recuperated once the session has finished.
- 3. Do not eat during class. It is recommended to bring a water bottle.

- 5. Parents must arrive on time for drop-off and pick-up so as not to disrupt the class.
- 6. Anti-social behaviour (such as rude, aggressive, bullying, sexually suggestive or disruptive behaviour) will not be tolerated. This includes during class time and when communicating with any member of the Alliance Française East Anglia community.
- 7. In line with the Alliance Française values of respect and common benefit, students must not discriminate based on nationality, race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, age, disability, political beliefs, marital status, or parental status.
- 8. The teacher reserves the right to ask students to leave the class if they display behaviour that is threatening to anyone present or negatively affects the atmosphere of the class. In such a case, the student will automatically be referred to the Management Team of the Alliance Française East Anglia and will be asked to attend a meeting before returning to the next class session.

We reserve the right to refuse admission to any class or to ask students to leave the lesson in the event of serious or repeated violations of this Code of Conduct.
